The school is all set to welcome back our students after the summer vacations. We will be following the latest updates from the Ministry to ensure a safe, healthy and learning rich environment for our students

**Mode of Schooling-Grades 1-12**

- For existing and newly admitted students the school will offer only online classes from 29 August 2021 till 2nd September 2021.
- For existing and newly admitted students, from 5th September 2021, the school will offer both on campus face to face learning and distance/online learning on a daily basis where both groups of students will receive learning and instructional delivery simultaneously.

**School Timing:** From 29 August to 2nd September - 8:00 am to 1:10 pm  
From 5th September onward - 8:00 am to 1:30 pm

**Guidelines for Face to Face Mode of Schooling**

*The operation protocol of educational institutes during the pandemic as per National Emergency Crisis and Disasters Management Authority is as given below.*

- The protocol will be applied 30 days from the first day of school to give all unvaccinated individuals an opportunity to take the vaccine. During this period all vaccinated and unvaccinated students will be required to take a PCR test every two weeks.
- After 30 days unvaccinated students under 12 and vaccinated students aged 12 and over will have to take one PCR test per month.
- Unvaccinated students aged 12 and over must conduct weekly PCR test. Distance learning will be available to vaccinated and unvaccinated students of all ages.
- Parents will be required to download Al Hosn application and present to the school printed PCR and vaccinated certificates.
- Parents are required to submit the Consent Form (**Annexure 1**) along with the Health Declaration (**Annexure 2**) for their wards if they are opting for onsite schooling latest by **28th August 2021**. Please submit to the class teacher through Whatsapp number/email/Orison portal.
- Once the learning mode is selected students will not be allowed to switch learning mode in the middle of the school term.

**Note:** Students above the age of 12 opted for face to face learning can take the PCR test on 02/09/2021 (Thursday) for reporting physically to school on 5th September 2021 and can submit the test report to the respective Class teacher on 04/09/2021 through Whatsapp/email/ Orison portal.

We request parents to follow these directives as applicable to their wards. School will ensure all precautions and guidelines as issued by relevant authorities are followed and implemented.
