The following are the new recent entry requirements to attend school face to face (Onsite)

1. All the students should show negative PCR done within 96 hours prior to joining the school.
2. Please download the Consent and Health Declaration form from the below links.

Filled in forms and PCR Test report should be uploaded in the below link on or before **04/09/2021**.

3. During the first month, from the first day of school all students aged below 12 years, who have opted face to face mode of schooling, must submit a PCR test once in every month.
4. During the first month, students aged 12 and above, vaccinated or unvaccinated, must submit the PCR test once every two weeks.
5. The students can do PCR in any MOHAP Health Centers.
6. From 3 to 11 Years of age children can take the Sinopharm vaccine which is available in any MOHAP Health Centers.
7. From 12 Years and above children have a choice of either Pfizer or Sinopharm Vaccination which is available in Health centers.

NOTE: IN BOTH THE CASES PARENTS SHOULD BE THERE WITH ORIGINAL EMIRATES ID OF THE CHILD.

The following are the centers for PCR with timings:

- **Mushairef Only on Saturday**
 - 8 am to 12pm(Morning)
 - 5 pm to 10 pm (Evening)
- **Grand Mall (Age group - Less than 12yrs only)**
 - Saturday from 5 pm to 10 pm only
- **Khalifa Hall**
 - Friday and Saturday from 10am to 4 pm for all age groups
