Dear Parents,

“Greetings from IIS Family”

As we have physically reopened school for onsite classes in Term 2, AY 21-22 for the students who have opted face to face mode of learning, it is our utmost priority to ensure the safety of all the students and staff reporting to school by adhering to the covid protocols received from MOE.

We would, therefore, like to bring to your notice that in case any of the family members including the parents, siblings or the student himself/herself is feeling unwell or showing any symptoms which resembles that of covid 19, the concerned student must stay at home and is not allowed to attend the school physically. Parents are requested to follow the **Stay at Home if Unwell Policy** which was shared earlier, applicable for KG-XII. They should immediately go for PCR test to rule out the possibility of being covid positive and wait until the result comes to send their ward to the school physically.

If the result is negative the student can attend the school physically. If the result comes positive, the parents should immediately inform the respective Class teacher and the student can continue his/her classes in online mode and must quarantine for 14 days until the result comes negative. This will reduce the risk for the student's fellow classmates and teachers and other primary contacts in case of covid positive situation.

Expecting you understanding and cooperation in this regard.

Note: The school will share shortly a detailed **Parent Communication Plan** for onsite students, KG-XII which needs to be strictly adhered to. The guidelines in the Parent Communication Plan is in accordance with the Eighth Edition: Operation of Educational Establishments during the Pandemic: Protocols & Procedures from MOE.
