As we have communicated before, on **10th January 2022**, the school along with sister Habitat schools will attempt a new Guinness World Records (GWR) title in the category ***“Most users in a Web Development Video Hangout”***. This record attempt will be an **online event** and students who have completed their web development projects will be participating in this event from home. This event will showcase our students coding and web development skills on a global platform.

Before the final event on 10th January 2022, a trial is also planned for 8th January 2022 to ensure students are prepared well for the event day. Participating students will receive information and directions from their Class Teacher so that they are able to join in time. Parents are requested to ensure uninterrupted internet connectivity for the final GWR event.

As most faculty of the school will be engaged in the event on 10th January 2022, below is the schedule school will maintain on Final Event day for participating and non-participating students.

- 1. Grade 4-12 participating students** to join trial and main GWR event as per schedule shared by the Class Teachers.

Event start time 8: 30 am. **Event End time** 12: 30 pm.
Students joining schedule: As communicated by Class teacher
- 2. Grade 4-12 non-participating students** who have not completed their Web Development project will not have a live class schedule on Event day and it will be a non-instructional working day for these students. Class teachers will share assignment/academic work for the day that needs to be completed and submitted.
- 3. For Grade 2 and 3**, classes will operate online as usual.
For Grade 1 - It will be a non-instructional working day for the students and no live classes will be scheduled. Class teachers will share assignment/academic work for the day that will need to be completed and submitted
- 4. KG:** Online classes will be conducted as usual
