School Reopening for Onsite, Term 3, AY 2021- 22

Dear Parents,

“Greetings from IIS Family”

This is to inform you all about the updates from the **Ministry of Education**, to be followed by all the parents and students hence forth to ensure a safe, healthy learning environment for our students.

From 31st January 2022, School will resume Onsite Schooling for all students from KG to Grade XII. However if you do not want to send your ward to school due to medical or any other reasons, school will offer the online option. You will have to submit a **Consent Form** and **Health declaration forms** for the same which are given in the circular as **Annexure 1 & Annexure 2**.

Parents are advised to note the below points.

- Parents are advised to follow the below Timings and refer the circular IIS/CIR/051/2021-2022 (<https://bit.ly/3rJFmqL>) for **Annexure 2 – Code of Conduct of Onsite Schooling** to be followed strictly.

- The school will offer both Face to face learning and Distance/Online learning on a daily basis where both groups of students will receive learning and instructional delivery simultaneously from Grade I- XII.
- Students from KG-XII will receive the **Revised Bell timings** from the respective Class teachers on or before 27th January 2022 through the Orison portal or WhatsApp broadcast group.
- The OT parents are advised to drop and pick their wards to and from the school respectively at 7.30 am (arrival) and 2.40 pm on regular days & on Friday at 11.15 am (dispersal from the respective OT Rooms). Parents are advised not to use the back entry and exit gates of the school during arrival & dispersal time.

MANDATORY SUBMISSIONS FOR ONSITE (FACE TO FACE) SCHOOLING MODE KG TO GRADE XII.

1. *Parents must submit,*
 - ◆ Consent form for **both online & onsite students**
 - ◆ Health declaration form **only for onsite students**
 - ◆ School transport details if opting for this.

All the above forms and details of transport must be submitted in the link given and returned on **or before 26th January 2022.** <https://forms.gle/wNlgV9zUW2QMMC6Y8>

2. *Parents must submit,*

- ◆ NEGATIVE PCR Test Result of their ward with (96) hours validity before joining the school in the link which will be shared by the school **on or before 26th January 2022.**

3. *Students must follow and adhere to,*

- ◆ The COVID -19 protocols as instructed by MOH & MOE - maintaining a safe distance at all times, in the classrooms as well as in the corridors and other areas of premises, wearing masks and using hand sanitizers whenever necessary.
- ◆ Learning mode selected at the start. Students will not be allowed to switch learning mode in the middle of the school term.

4. *Parents will be required to,*

- ◆ Download Al Hosn App and present to the school printed Negative results of their wards which must be available with them always.
- ◆ Show a 96-hour negative PCR test and Al Hosn Green Pass to enter school premises.

We request parents to follow these guidelines as applicable to their wards and themselves. School will ensure all precautions and Guidelines as issued by the concerned authorities.

Important Information: For the Board students of **Grade IX-XII**, the school is strongly suggesting that all the students must return for **onsite classes w.e.f 31st January 2022** as CBSE Term 2 Board Examination, AY 21-22 is fast approaching and the students need guidance and more practice by the concerned subject teachers due to the change in **Assessment Scheme** before they appear for Annual/CBSE Examination. Parents are advised to look into this and your understanding and cooperation is highly required in this regard.

HEALTH DECLARATION FORM KG – XII, TERM 3, AY 2021-22

It is mandatory to submit this declaration for students opting for onsite campus schooling.
