Two levels of Board Examinations in Mathematics

Dear Parents,
Greetings!

"It was decided by CBSE to hold two levels of Board Examinations in Mathematics for class X from the year 2020 onwards; the same shall not be applicable to the internal assessment in class X. The levels are given below:

First level - Mathematics Standard - the level of the question paper will be the same as before the introduction of the two levels (Before the year 2020)

Second level - Mathematics Basic - easier compared to the Mathematics Standard paper.

The syllabus, classroom teaching and internal assessment for both levels of examination remain the same, only question papers for the Board Examination will be different for the two levels. Based on the above declaration made by CBSE, the school has decided to execute this opportunity as detailed below;

Please note that Mathematics Standard level will be meant for students who wish to opt for Mathematic at Senior Secondary level and Mathematics Basic level for students not keen to pursue Mathematics at higher level.

However CBSE offers an alternative for those who opt Mathematics Basic to appear in Mathematics Standard at the time of compartment examination in case he/she changes his/her mind to pursue Mathematics at Senior Secondary level.

Kindly fill the below Acknowledgement form and submit the hardcopy to the respective Class Teacher on or before 15th May 2023. After the deadline, no further requests will be accepted.

Note: Once the parent confirms the level of Mathematics Standard/Basic for his/her ward, it cannot be changed. Any change from CBSE in regard to this circular will be intimated accordingly.
