CBSE Assessment & Practice -AY 2023-24

Your ward will go for the CBSE board examination which will be held in the month of February, March 2024. As per the CBSE new assessment scheme, more Competency Based questions are added in core subjects. The Competency Based Questions will assess the application of concepts in real-life/ unfamiliar situations in subjects.

Questions in the CBSE Board Exams will include:

Multiple-choice questions (MCQs)

Case based questions

Source-based integrated questions

The Academic year is divided into 2 terms and each term will have a Formative assessment and a Summative assessment. By the end of the academic year, there will be a model examination as per CBSE criteria, including a practical exam for grade 12. For ministry subjects (Islamic studies, Arabic, Moral and cultural studies) school assessment will take place.

STREAM SELECTION PROCESS OF GRADE 11.

The selection process is as per the criteria of grade 10 model examination score, student behavior and attendance.

- The eligibility will be given to students who score 70 % and above in all subjects.
- The students who have good behavior history and minimum attendance (75% as per CBSE criteria)

STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

- Regular attendance and punctuality are very essential for all board students to make good progress. It is the responsibility of Parents to ensure that this is achieved.
- If the student is repeatedly late for morning assembly ,this will be considered as 3rd degree of offense and as per Behavior Management Policy necessary actions will be taken.
- If the child is unwell, kindly intimate the absence either through the school diary or mail to the class teacher or through official WhatsApp. The school will not authorize absence unless it is supported by Medical documents or any emergencies. Long leaves will not be approved for requests such as vacation or family functions. The school will not encourage such requests from parents.
- No student can leave the school premises during school hours without Exit slips.
- Students must wear neat and ironed uniforms as prescribed by the school.
- Students are not allowed to wear any dress which is not part of the prescribed uniform.
- Hair must be neatly trimmed for boys and two plaits for girls.
- Students must bring their own study materials as per time table.
- Important Clause: Students should not bring prohibited items such as Whitener, Steal Blade,Electronic cigarettes, perfumes or prohibited substances.
- Bringing mobile phones is prohibited and it can be considered as a 2nd degree of offense as per BMP.

SCHOOL COMMUNICATION CHANNEL

- Business WhatsApp broadcast group and parental portal are the official communication channels.(Parents will be added to the broadcast group by the respective Class Teachers. Kindly save the teacher's number so that you may not miss any messages).
- Parents are instructed to follow the official time for communicating with class teachers.
- If there is any LOC Works- related documentation & verification, the parent has to report to the school as instructed by the Class teacher.
- If any complaints and concerns are there , parents can raise them to the class teacher/ Section Counsellor or Section Head.

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS

- Students are also expected to carry their prescribed books including stationery in a pouch (Crayons, sharpened pencils, eraser, glue sticks, marked with his/her name on them).
- CBSE rules require a student to have a minimum attendance of 75 % , anyone falling short is not allowed to sit for the CBSE examination.
- Leaves are not encouraged unless it is a medical emergency and the student is advised to submit the medical record to the class teacher and inform prior to the leave day.
- School diary will be given to your ward. It is the main source of Communication between teachers and parents. Kindly ensure that the child brings the diary every day.
