This event will provide students with an opportunity to explore new ideas, experiment with new technologies and come up with innovative solutions to the world problems.

Parents are requested to note the below guidelines:

- Students can prepare the *innovative* projects (Working/Still) integrated to the subjects Science, Maths and IT and can include SDG & COP28 initiatives in their project.
- The project has to be *innovative* in all the aspects and students must *refrain* from presenting the same projects presented for usual STEM exhibition.
- Participation is individual and must submit one exhibit by integrating the innovative concepts of Science/Maths/IT.
- The competition is phase wise and there will be an internal selection based on the rubrics from which best 30 exhibits will be selected from each phase as given below.

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Grade	Phases
KG	Phase I
Grade 1- IV	Phase 2
Grade V- VIII	Phase 3
Grade IX - XII	Phase 4

- Students will get **Best Innovator Award** for the 1st, 2nd & 3rd positions across phases.
- Interested students can submit their Exhibits to their respective class teachers **on or before 29th October** for the selection.
- Parents can also participate in the competition along with their wards. Interested parents can send confirmation to the respective Section Heads through the Email. The parents will be notified about their participation after the screening and selection of the Exhibits.

The following criteria will be used to evaluate the exhibit:

- 1. Creativity and imagination
- 2. Originality and innovativeness
- 3. Scientific thought / Principle
- 4. Relevance to society/Problem Solving
- 5. Presentation/Technical skills.

Parents are requested to encourage participation of their wards in the event to make the **Innovators Day** a grand success.
