Dear Parents,

Please be informed that there will be an **Annual Class party** for **KG to Grade VIII** students on **6th February 2026, Friday** and it will be conducted during the **school-working hours**.

The Class Party will provide a valuable lesson to all the students on “Sharing and Caring”; a message to make the students sensitive towards wastage of food; A Day to count the blessings the students have experienced in this academic year. Students will be given the opportunity to share their experience and thank teachers. We celebrate differences, cherish diversity, so this will also give a space for the students from different countries and regions to share, mingle and interact and make them experience how a small classroom can become truly global, inclusive and healthy.

Note:

1. The Guidelines for the **KG Class party** will be shared by the respective class teachers
2. The students from **Grade 1 to VIII** will have class party from 7:45am till 9:25am followed by regular class.
3. The students **from Grade I to VIII** shall wear Modest colour dress for the Class Party.
4. Students must carry a minimum of healthy home-made food. Ordering food from the school, reception, and sections and borrowing phones from teachers to order junk food (pizza, burger, carbonated drinks, cakes, etc...) is not allowed at all.
5. Parents should refrain from sending the following banned food items to school as per MOE. (Hotdogs and processed meat, instant noodles, chocolate bars, chocolate spreads, sweets, lollipops and jelly, peanut products, potato and corn chips, carbonated drinks, cream cakes, doughnuts and other junk food items).
6. Students should ensure to maintain the classroom cleanliness during and after the class party as it will be monitored strictly by the Class teachers.
7. Students should maintain proper hygiene while handling the food to avoid any contamination or food poisoning.
8. Students should not carry mobile phones or any electronic gadgets as these items are banned as per CBSE and MOE norms. If cases are reported, as per Behavior Management Policy, strict actions will be taken.
9. Party Spray, music and decoration in the corridors or classrooms are not allowed. Possession of prohibited items, including sharp objects, is strictly forbidden on school premises and school Bus.
10. If any student is found not obeying the rules and regulation set by the school for Class Party, actions will be taken as per MOE Behavior Management Policy and that will affect the Behavior Score of the student.
