What are the noises you can hear and colours you can see from your room? Make a list and write descriptions of them in a notebook.

Keep watching the rain, sunshine and wind from your room and see what you can find about such natural events from this practice.

Practise arranging different corners of your home neatly.

Do you have plants in your house? If yes, understand their name and specialities. If no, plant a couple of them in pots or in the compound. Take good care of them.

Keep some water outside your house for birds every day - neither too hot nor cold. Identify the time when the birds come to drink water and replace fresh water regularly. Observe the birds and look up their specialities online and write notes. Do not keep water bowls on window ledges but only on balconies.

Read a minimum of 1 or 2 books. Sketch/photography different parts of your house or surroundings.





What are the things required in the kitchen? Make a list based on your kitchen.

Make a list of the kinds of works involved in cooking.

Make a digital photo collection of different kinds of food made at home. Write small notes describing the item along with your experience of eating it.

Make a week-long healthy menu for the kitchen in consultation with your parents.





LET'S EXPLORE HEALTH

Make a chart of physical exercises/ yoga/drill/dance/work out for the summer.

With the help of your parents find out good indoor games that are best for health and also fun.

Learn ways to give exercise to eyes and practise them regularly.

Count the time you are spending for physical activities every day.

Find out about the most healthy food items and make a list.







Ask your parents about their favourite food, colour, place, childhood memory, teacher, school vacation and trip. Write about this in your diary.

Talk to your siblings and find out what they plan to do when they grow up.

Find a regular time to communicate with your grandparents, relatives and cousins through online mediums and find out from your cousins how their experience of the vacation was.

Find out about the native places of your mother and father through these conversations.

Make a family album with your parents, siblings and cousins from earlier times and write captions to these photos.
