viii. Spellathon

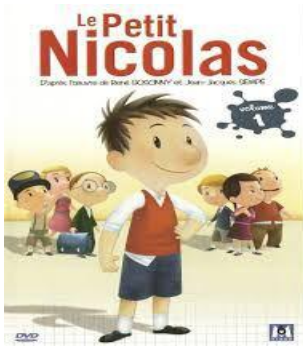

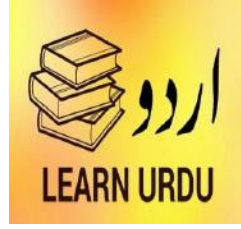

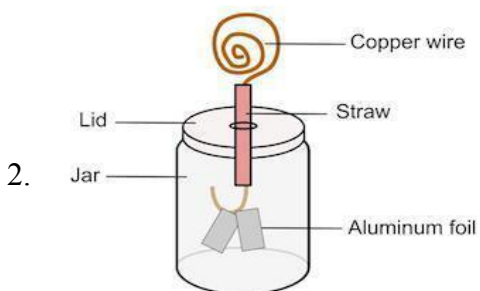
